
We will discuss children's likes and dislikes and healthy habits including food, rest, exercise, dentist visits to maintain a healthy body and healthy mind. Throughout the term we will also cover Chinese New Year and Winter time.



We will continue to choose a daily helper to develop children's self-help skills and independence - they will help clear snack, be the line leader to guide the children and help their friends in need. Alongside our positive behaviour chart, we will also give out the Superstar box to encourage positive behaviour, positive attitude and celebrate individual achievement. The children will be given a certificate to take home stating why it was awarded and they will be allowed to bring a special item/toy from home to show their friends at registration time.

Forest school

We will be resuming our Forest school sessions, weather permitting and will let you know the dates. We will provide wellies and overalls but please make sure your child wears weather appropriate clothing.



Snack, Nappy sacks and baby wipes

We would be appreciative if you could donate wipes and nappy sacks from time to time, nappies if your child is using them and contribute a daily healthy snack so that we can offer a variety of morning and afternoon snacks to all the children - fruit, vegetables, raisins, breadsticks and occasionally biscuits. Please do not bring Kiwi fruits and products containing nuts due to severe allergies at Pre-school and remember to update your child's diet requirements, if any.

Pre-school fees and Funded forms

Two Year olds - Early Years Review and Health Review

When your child reaches two years of age, you will be offered an Early Years Review if they attend an Ofsted registered childcare (e.g. a nursery, pre-school or childminder). At 27 months of age, your child will be offered a Health Review and you will also receive two ages- and-stages questionnaires in the post. Pre-school will carry out a two-year assessment which should be kept in your child's personal child health record "Red Book" and will be reviewed by the health professional during your child's Health Review. Can we please ask you forward a copy of the reviews when you receive them.
